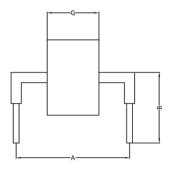
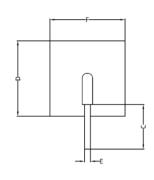

## **Wave Solder Profile**

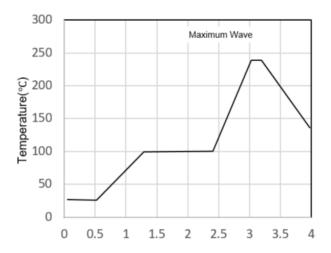


Fig 1. Non Lead-free profile

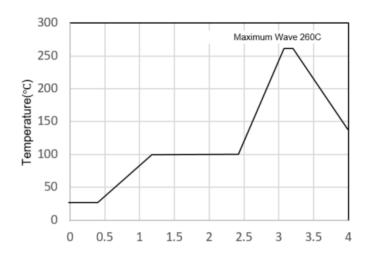
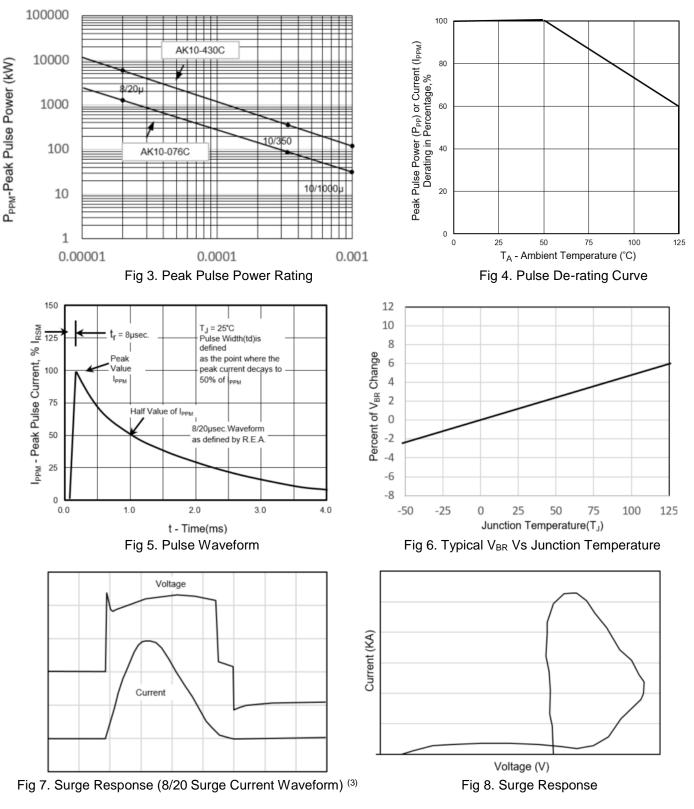


Fig 2. Lead-free profile

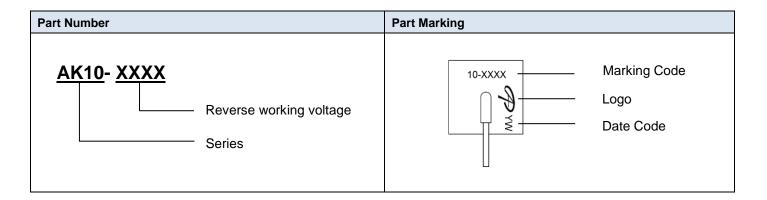
