## II. Reliability Evaluation

FIT rate (per billion): 2.61 MTTF = 43670 years

The presentation of FIT rate for the individual product reliability is restricted by the actual burn-in sample size. Failure Rate Determination is based on JEDEC Standard JESD 85. FIT means one failure per billion hours.

**Failure Rate** =  $Chi^2 x 10^9 / [2 (N) (H) (Af)] = 2.61$ **MTTF** =  $10^9 / FIT = 43670 \text{ years}$
